I recommend Keystone SWANA move to membership or association software. It can house the Chapter website, create and market events, and manage member communications. This software does incur a monthly cost, unlike our current website. However, there are significant costs to make any modifications to our current site that association software will not have (ex. adding "Safety", "Young Professionals", and changing the logo). Additionally, because association software can handle mass emails, the monthly cost of \$21.20 for Constant Contact (our email marketing software) will be eliminated.

Association software will give us control over content, additions, and modifications of the Chapter website. It has many mobile responsive templates to start building our website. The html and CSS code can also be edited to customize the templates further. It provides extensive event management, including creating custom online registration forms, accepting and tracking event payments, mobile attendee check in, and easily adding additional attendees on site. Events can also be customized to offer early bird pricing, coupon codes, and member-only prices.

I am recommending Keystone SWANA moves to Wild Apricot for our Chapter's website, marketing, and communication needs.
